ADVANCED MATHEMATICS AND ADVANCED SCIENCE (CLASS IX) 2026-27

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has introduced an important academic initiative from the academic session 2026-27, enabling students of Class IX to opt for Advanced Mathematics and/or Advanced Science in addition to the regular curriculum.

The objective of these advanced courses is to provide academically inclined students with opportunities for deeper learning, enhanced conceptual understanding, analytical reasoning, critical thinking, and higher-order problem-solving skills. These courses are particularly beneficial for students who have a strong interest and aptitude in Mathematics and Science and wish to explore these subjects beyond the standard curriculum.

Important Points

1. The Advanced courses are optional and will be offered as an additional academic challenge over and above the regular syllabus to the students who want to opt the same.

Available Options

Students may choose any one of the following options:

- No Advanced Subject
 - Advanced Mathematics only
 - Advanced Science only
 - Both Advanced Mathematics and Advanced Science
2. To support students enrolled in advanced courses, the school would conduct additional offline and/or online classes, assignments, and assessments as and when required.

Assessment Pattern

Advanced Mathematics/Advanced Science (Optional)

- Additional syllabus beyond the regular curriculum
- Frequency: Once a year with only Annual Examination
- Advanced Examination: 25 Marks
- Duration: 1 Hour
(On the same day as of regular annual examination of the particular subject, with a break of 30 minutes in between)
- Focus on: Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOTS)
 - Application-based learning
 - Analytical reasoning
 - Conceptual depth
 - Advanced problem-solving

Kaushal Vikas (CLASS IX) 2026-27

In continuation of our commitment to holistic education and in alignment with the NEP- 2020 and the NCFSE 2023. Indirapuram Public School is pleased to introduce Kaushal Bodh for Classes VI-VIII and KaushalVikas for Class IX as part of the regular school curriculum. These sessions are being conducted during the First Period as notified earlier.

Kaushal Bodh (Classes VI-VIII) introduces students to vocational awareness through age-appropriate projects, while KaushalVikas (Class IX) builds transferable skills and deeper vocational competencies through authentic work experiences, preparing students for future careers and responsible citizenship.

The programmes are organised around Three Forms of Work, enabling students to understand the world of work through practical experiences:

1. Work with Life Forms: Learning through activities related to plants, animals and the environment,
2. Work with Machines and Materials: Developing practical skills by designing, creating, repairing and using tools.
3. Work in Human Services: Understanding the importance of service to society by interacting with people, identifying their needs and developing communication, empathy and teamwork.

The programme follows a continuous, competency-based assessment model that gives greater importance to practical learning than conventional written examinations. Students will be assessed through Activity Book and classroom tasks, Portfolio, Practical, Oral Presentation/Viva Voce, Teacher observations and Short written assessments twice a year with segregation as follows:

Promotion to Class X will be granted if the student:

1. Secures minimum 33% marks in all the below mentioned subjects(Theory and Internal assessment separately) :
 - Group-L (2 Languages)
 - Group-A1 (Mathematics, Science, Social Science)
2. The promotion to Grade X will be allowed even in case the student fails to get minimum 33% marks in Language-3 (R3) in Grade IX however, it is mandatory to get minimum 33% marks in R3 in Grade X (Internal assessment) to be eligible to appear for Board Examination.

B. ACTION FOR STUDENTS NOT PASSING ANNUAL EXAMINATION**Supplementary Examination Eligibility**

A student may be allowed to appear for Supplementary Examination(s) in a maximum of two subjects, including Skill Subject(s), as per the following combinations:(provided student is pass in Practical/Internal Assessment of subject in consideration)

- Any one subject from Mathematics/Science/Social Science and one Language.
- Any one subject from Mathematics/Science/Social Science and one Skill Subject.
- Any two subjects from Mathematics/Science/Social Science.
- One Language and one Skill Subject.

- Any two Languages.

Students Failing in Three Subjects

1. Failure in three subjects (excluding Skill Subject):

- No Supplementary Examination benefit shall be available.
- The student will be declared Detained/Essential Repeat in Class IX.

2. Failure in three subjects (including Skill Subject):

- Supplementary Examination shall be permitted in the two main academic subjects apart from Skill Subject.

Additional Conditions

1. Students absent in the Annual Examination without a valid and approved reason shall not be eligible for Supplementary Examination.
2. Supplementary Examination shall be conducted only once after the declaration of Annual Examination results.
3. The Supplementary Examination shall cover the entire annual syllabus.
4. The duration, pattern and maximum marks shall remain the same as the Annual Examination.
5. Where a student has already passed the Internal Assessment component, only the Theory Examination shall be repeated. Internal Assessment marks shall be carried forward.

C. PASSING CRITERIA AFTER SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATION

Promotion to Class X will be granted if the student:

1. Secures minimum 33% in both the Supplementary Examination undertaken.
2. If the student secures less than 33% marks in both the supplementary examinations he/she will be declared Detained/Essential Repeat in Grade IX .
3. If the student secures less than 33% marks in one of the supplementary examinations, the marks of the said subject would be replaced with that of the Skill Subject (provided the student has secured at least 33% marks in Skill Subject)
4. Annual report card shall reflect the marks obtained in the Annual Examination or Supplementary Examination, whichever is higher.

For Class X: [POLICY FOR TWO BOARD EXAMINATIONS BY CBSE :](#)

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has introduced a policy for conducting two Board examinations for Class X students, aligning with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. If this policy is officially implemented, the school will adhere to the new guidelines to ensure a smooth transition for students.

Key Points of the Policy:

- **Two Board Exams in One Academic Year:**
 - Students will have the option to appear in two board exams within the same academic session.
 - The best score of the two exams will be considered for the final result.
- **Full Syllabus Coverage:**
 - Both exams will cover the complete syllabus prescribed by CBSE.
- **Tentative Schedule:**
 - **First Board Exam: February/March**
 - **Second Board Exam: May/June**
- **Impact on Students:**
 - Students will get an opportunity to improve their scores.
 - It will reduce the pressure of a single high-stakes examination.
 - Encourages continuous and stress-free learning.
