SCHOOL HEALTH & WELLNESS PROJECT



Sports Club Foundational Stage







PARENT CONNECT & SCHOOL BOND

ALUMNA COLUMN

Kanika : Hey Yashvardhan! So glad to have you here. Let's get straight to it — what was your daily routine like during your JEE prep?

Yashvardhan Gautam : Hey, thank you so much for inviting me! Honestly, routines are different for everyone, but I'll share mine.

I used to wake up around 6 in the morning, do a bit of exercise — it helped me stay fresh. Then I'd study for a few hours at home before heading to my coaching, which was from 2 PM to around 9 PM. After that, dinner and some more study. But I soon realised that forcing myself to study late at night and cutting sleep wasn't helping. So I started adjusting and focusing more on how well I studied rather than how long I studied.

Kanika : Makes sense. Balancing school and JEE must've been super hectic though. How did you manage?

Yashvardhan Gautam : Oh absolutely! In Class II, school was online, so I thought I could attend school and prep for JEE at the same time. But yeah, that didn't go well at all. I felt like I was stuck — not doing great in school or JEE.

Eventually, I started using random free slots — like lunch breaks or free periods — to squeeze in JEE prep. In Class 12, I began attending school regularly and tried balancing both as best as I could. Around board exam time, I focused completely on school, skipped the Jan JEE attempt, and gave it a solid try in April.

After that, I took a year and joined Physics Wallah. That year really helped me go all-in for JEE.

Kanika : That's a journey in itself! What about books or resources — any favorites?

Yashvardhan Gautam : Honestly, solving PYQs — Previous Year Questions — was a game-changer. Before jumping into any big books, I just focused on those.

Other than that, I mostly stuck to whatever teachers recommended during coaching. They'd point out key questions from reference books, and I followed that. I wasn't aiming for AIR-1, but that approach really helped improve my scores.



Kanika : Totally relatable. And what kept you going during tough times?

Yashvardhan Gautam : JEE prep is a rollercoaster. There were so many ups and downs. But I kept reminding myself why I started — to get into a good college and do something I'm proud of.


Of course, I'd fall off track sometimes. But I always tried to get back up. I really believe that being consistent and having faith in your journey makes all the difference.



Kanika : That's genuinely inspiring. Lastly, any mistakes you'd like others to avoid?

Yashvardhan Gautam : Oh yes — one big academic mistake was not preparing Organic Chemistry properly. It's super important and scoring, and I kind of ignored it. so, I would suggest, don't ignore that at all!





Outside studies, I made the classic mistake of thinking I had to study all day, every day. But I later realised that taking breaks is necessary too. Spending time with family, watching something light, or reading manga helped me relax and recharge.

Also, I leaned a lot into my spiritual side. I used to chant the Hare Krishna Mahamantra — it gave me peace and helped me stay grounded.

So yeah, do take your prep seriously, but don't forget to live a little too. Make your own path, your own story.

Be spiritual.

Be loving.

Be generous.
