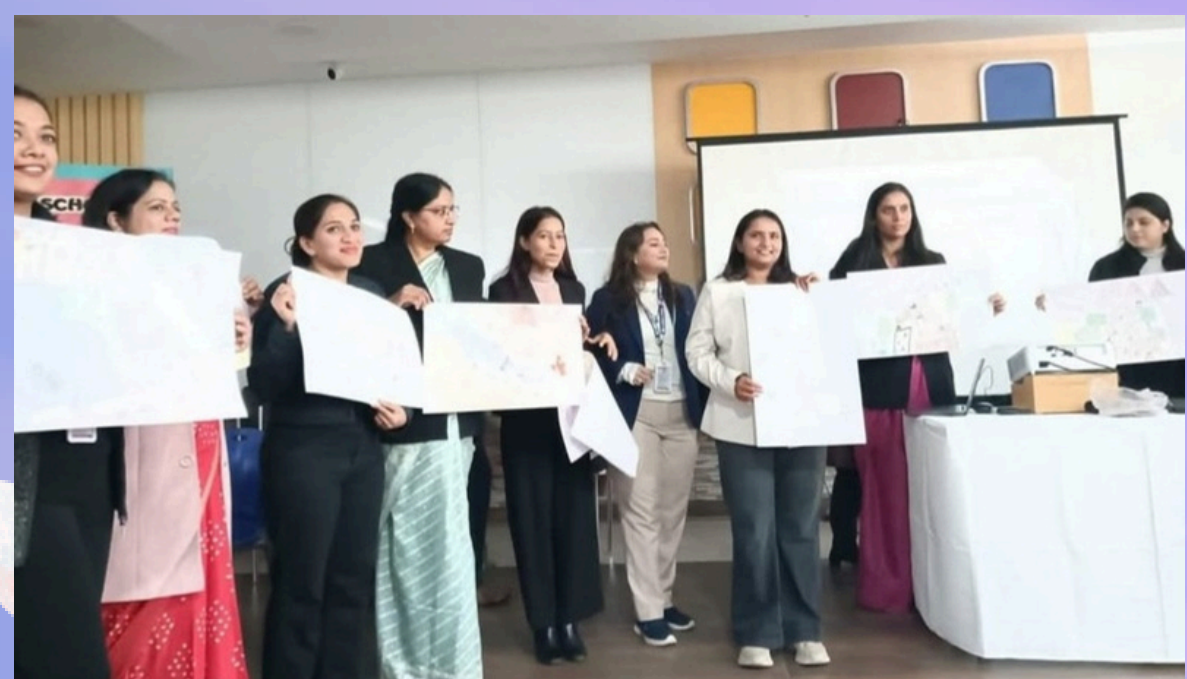
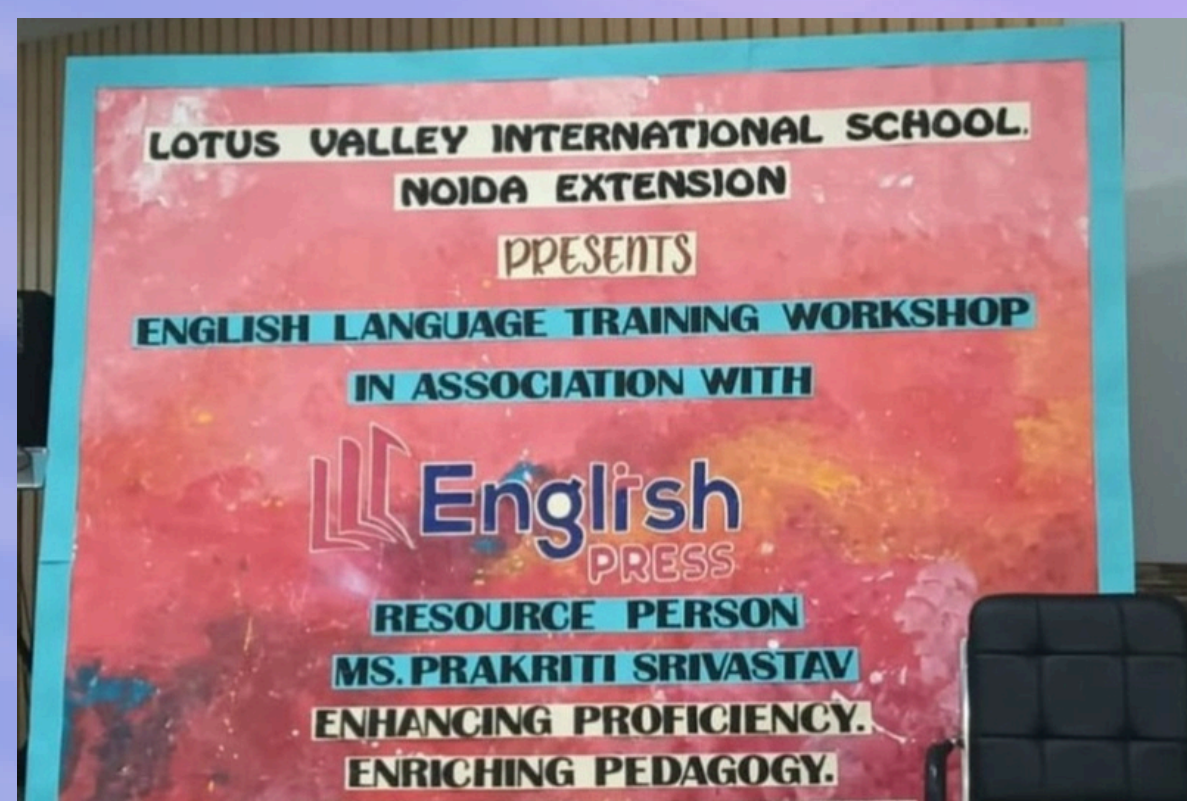
CBSE Capacity Building Programme - Stress Management:

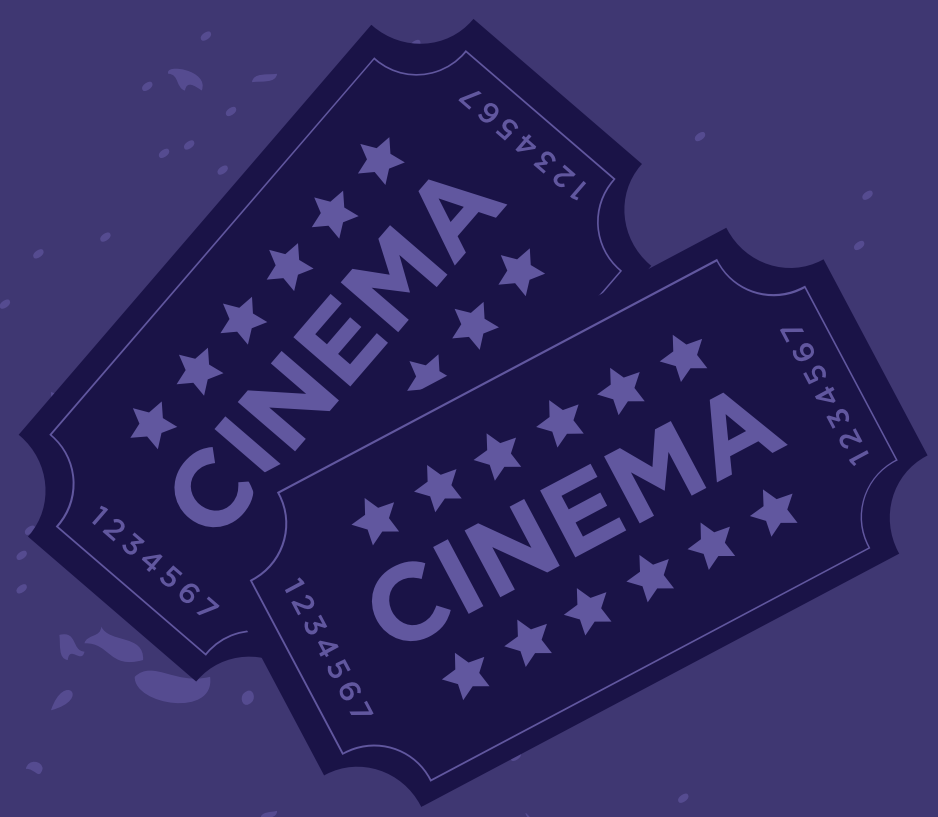
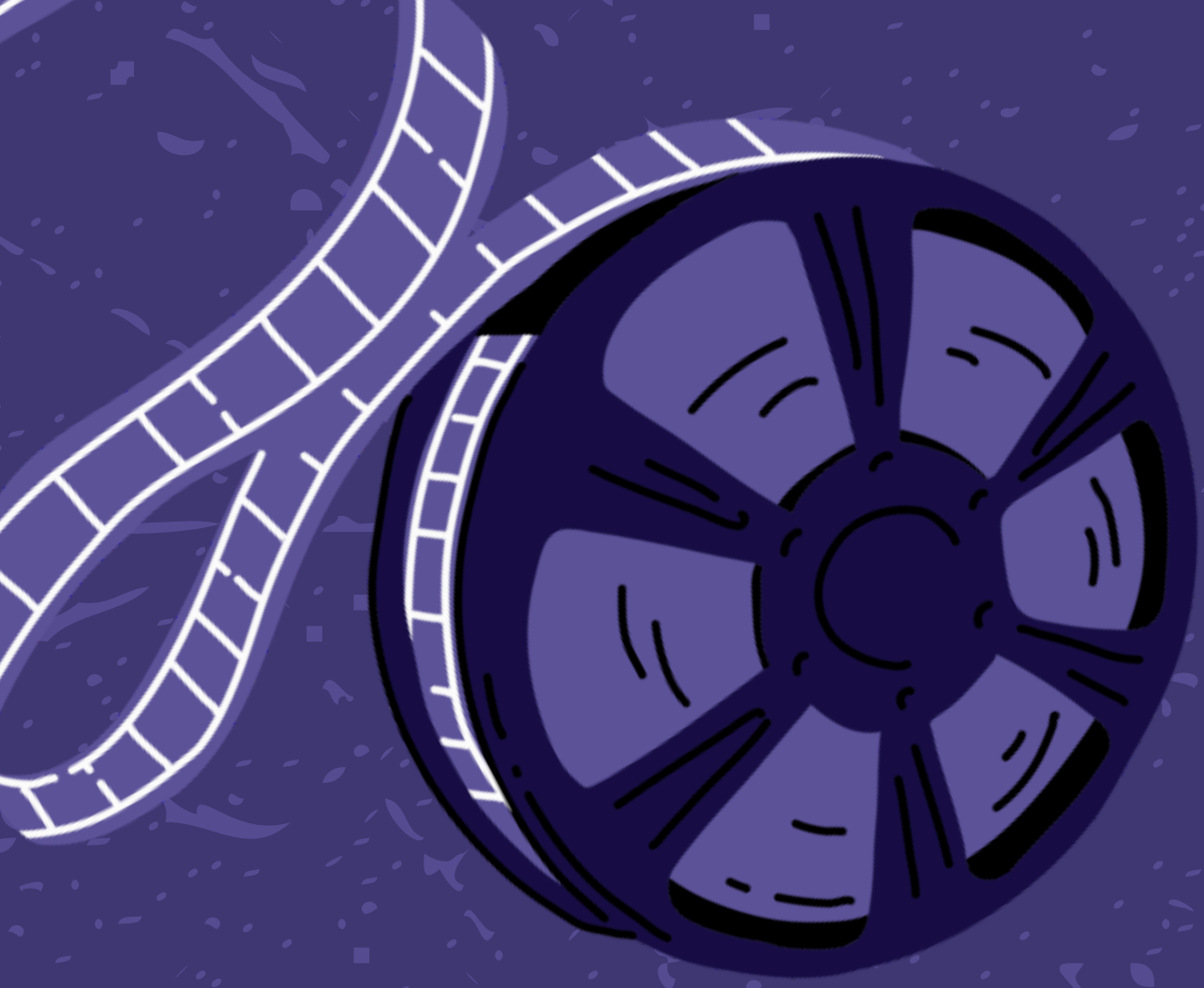


The 20th FICCI Higher Education Summit 2025

With the theme “Higher Education in a Transforming World: Bridging Borders, Building Futures,” the event brought together 40 leading universities and HEIs from India and abroad.

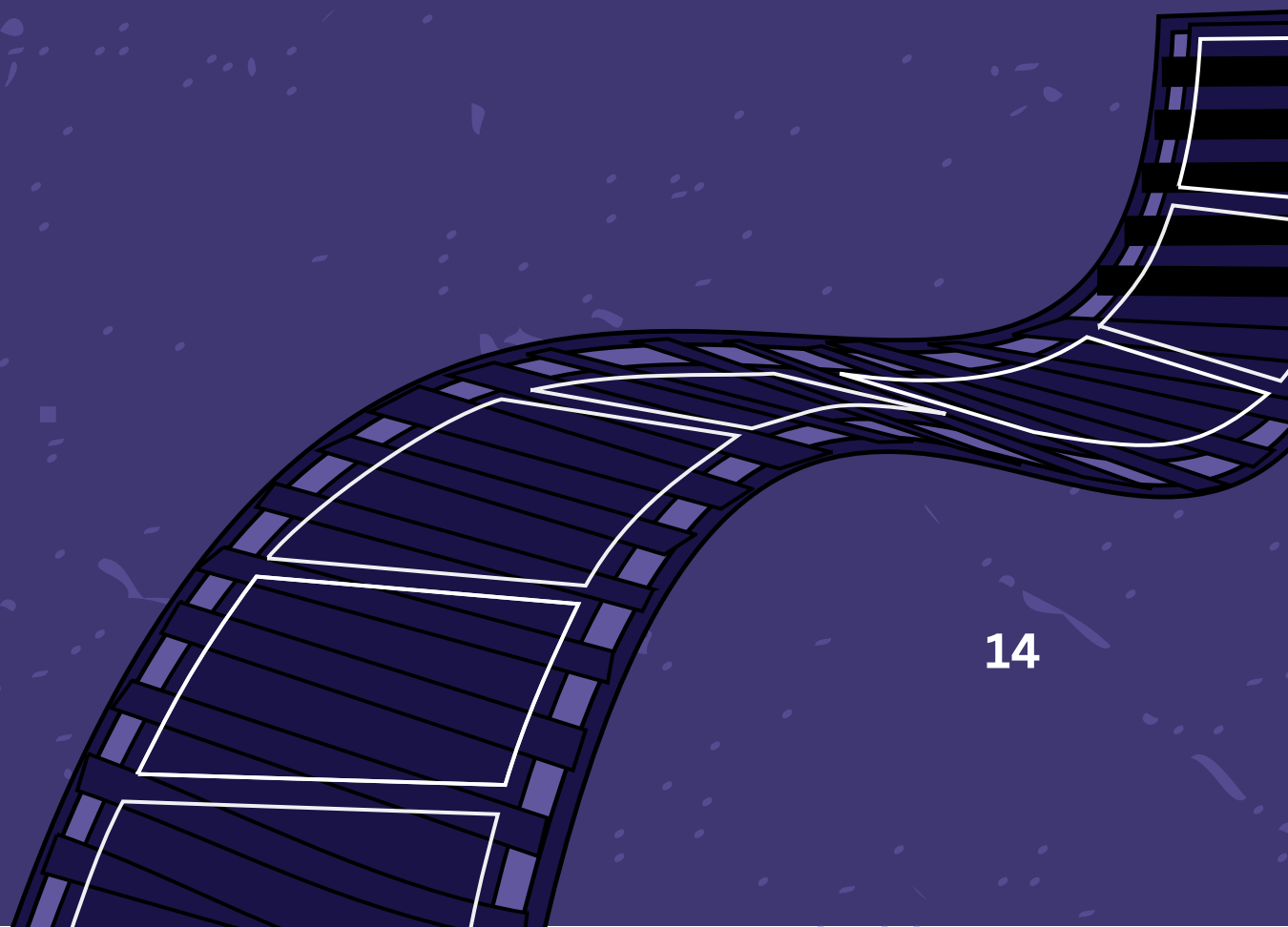

We all have to yearn, before we leave doubtful thoughts

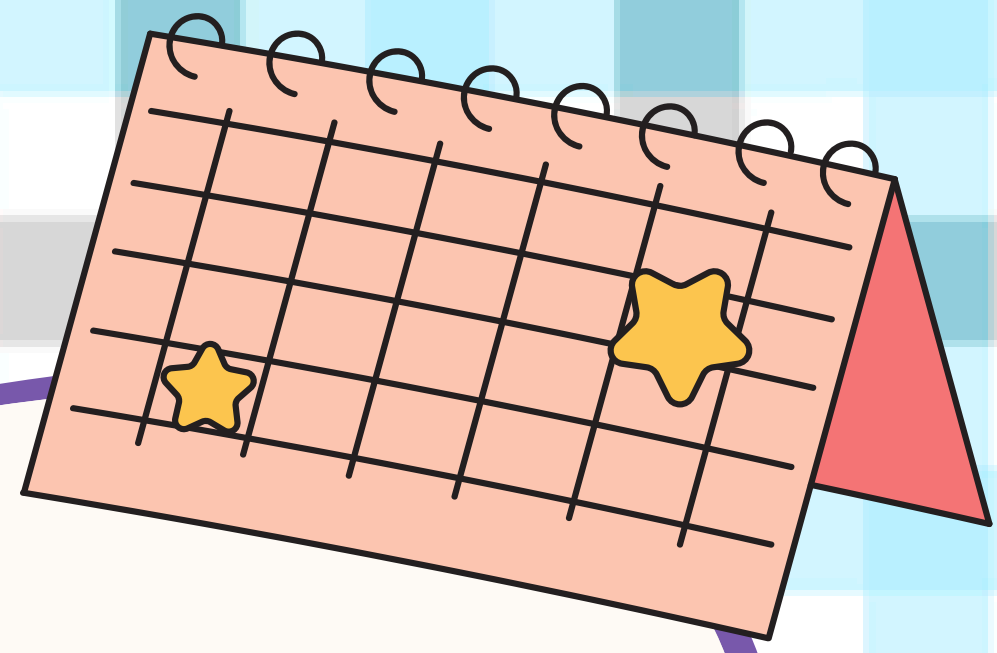
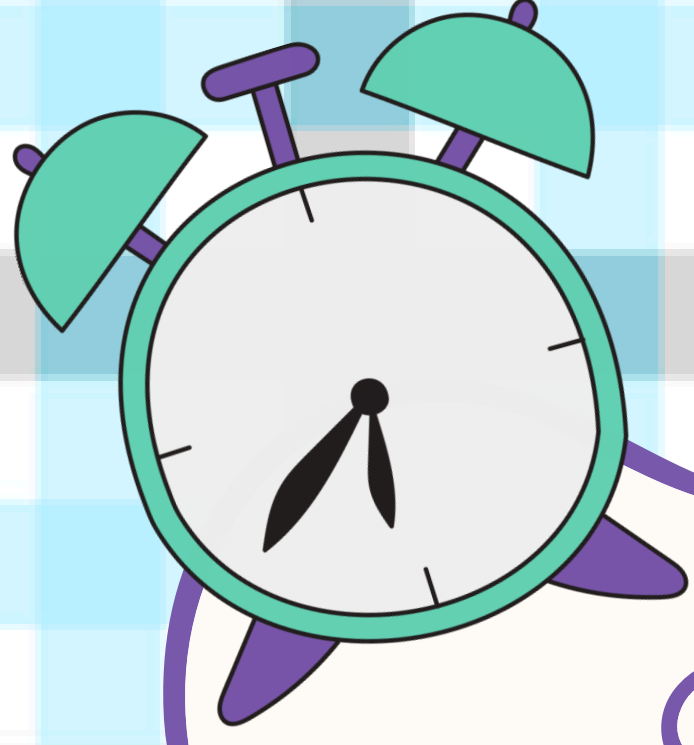
Every choice must matter

Back then, everything felt lighter.

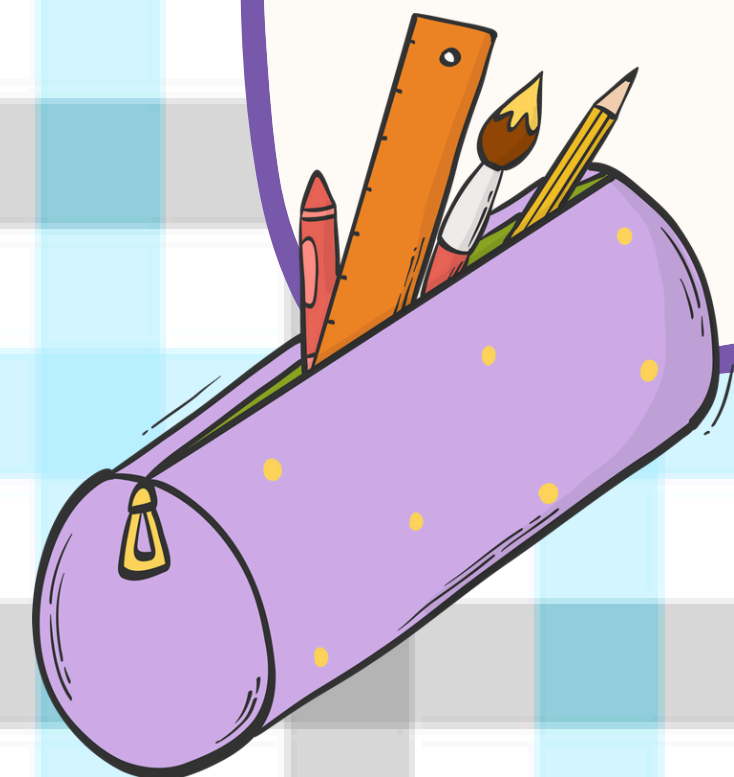
Like the world opened itself

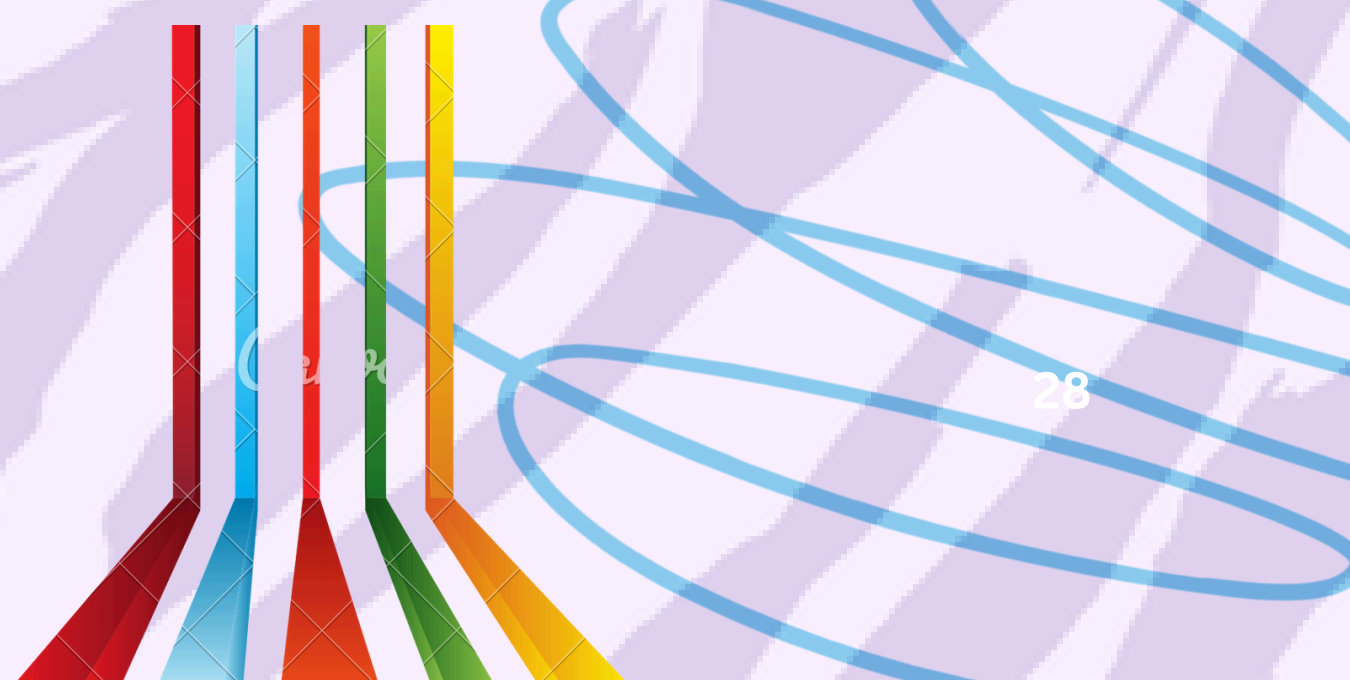
In mir liegt eine leise Palette,

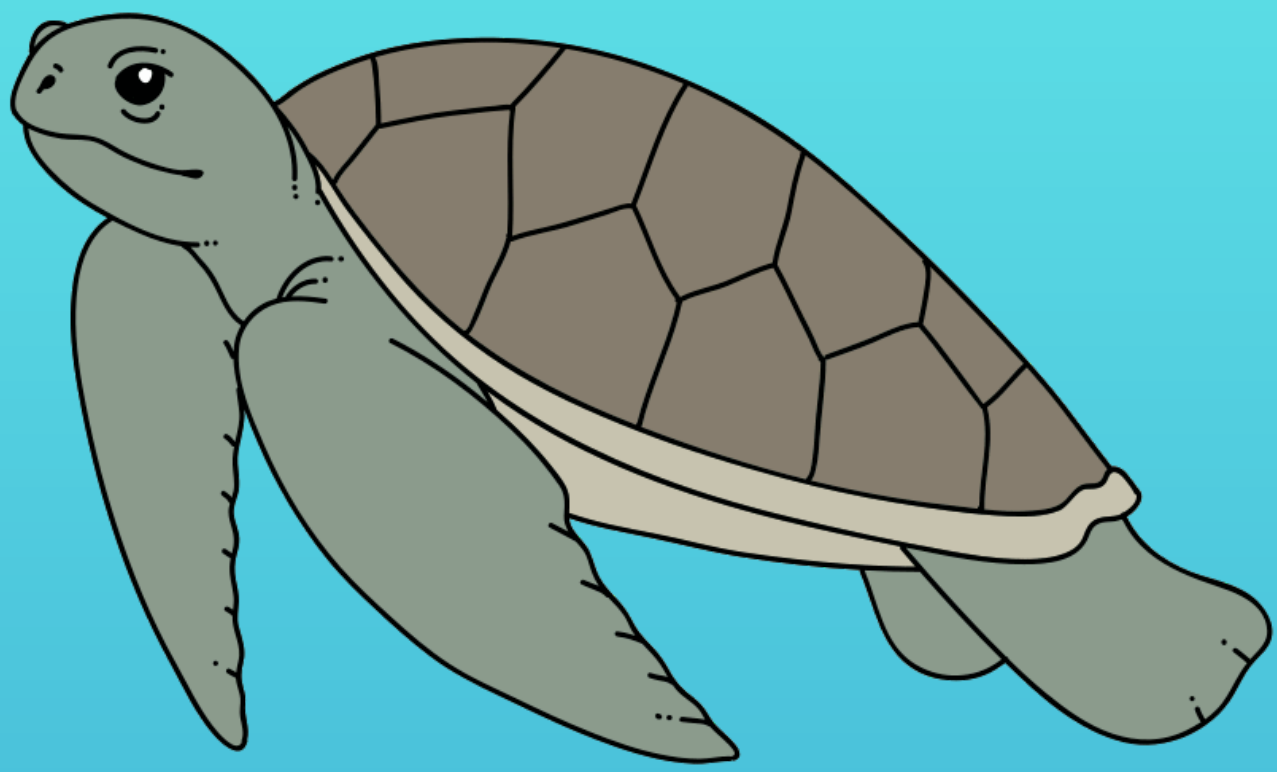

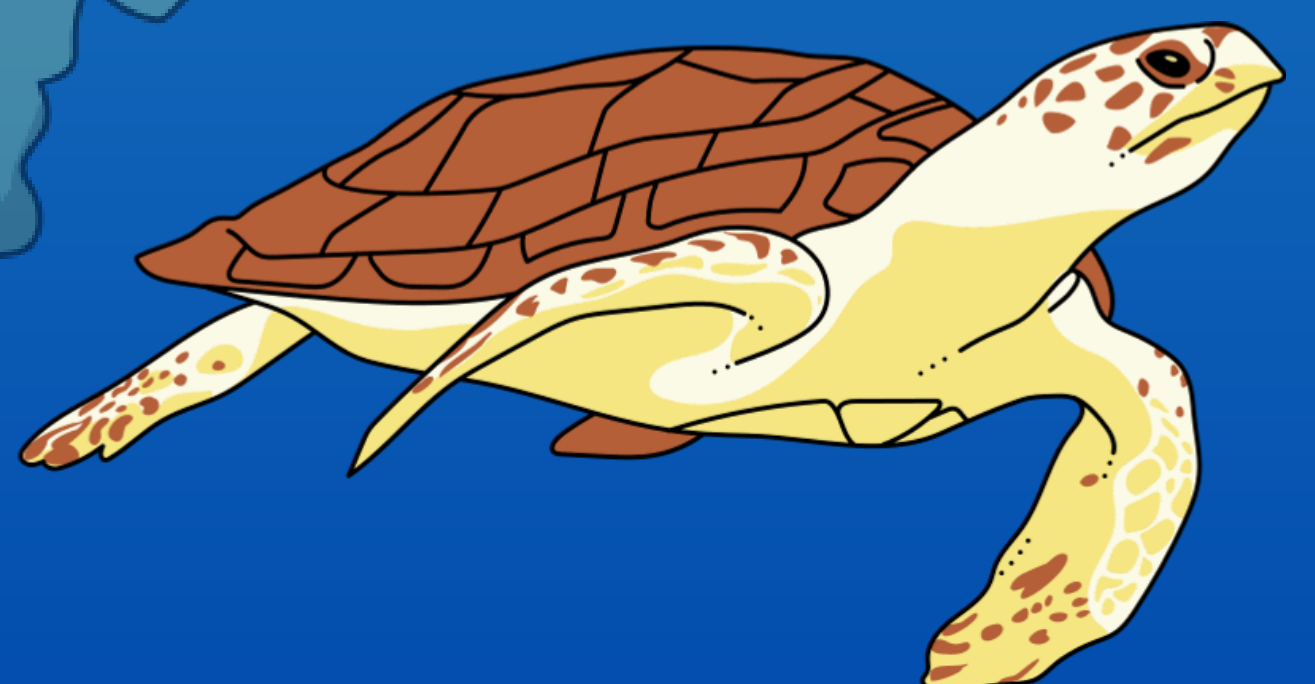
L'importance de l'environnement
